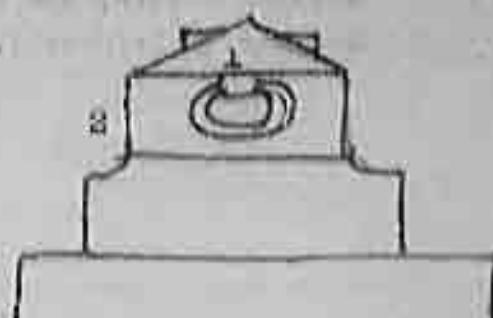

1. The Family Tomb of Robert Abraham Esq.
2. Millward p. 189, tomb 227:

n. side Sacred to the memory of Robert Abraham Esq. Architect / formerly of Keppel Street, Russell Square, who died 11th Decr 1850 aged 77, and of Eliza his wife who died 8th Decr 1818 aged 42 / Also of their children Horatio Nelson Abraham, died 21st Augst 1807 aged 18 months, Charlotte Frances who died 24th Janry 1819 / aged 19 months, Eliza Ann who died 4th April 1820 aged 19 years, Thomas Christian who died 9th Janry 1833 aged 24 years / Also of Frederick Hans Abraham d d 1841 aged 34 years, whose remains are in the cemetery at Leeds Yorkshire / Also of their grandchild Arthur Howard Bethell / son of Richard and Elinor Bethell / born 31st Janry 1833 / died 10th April 1834

n. side Herein also are deposited / the remains of / John Flower and Sydney Lombe Bethell sons of John and Louisa Bethell / and grandchildren of Robert Abraham who died in their infancy / Also of Mrs Lambert, a friend of the family and resident at Frognaal Hampton, who died 5th Feby 1851 aged 86
