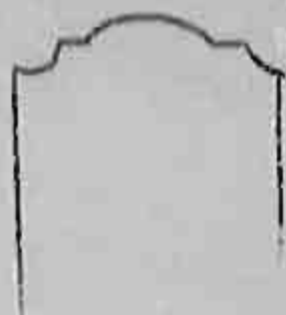

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS)

Discrepancy with Millward. On HS Mary Walker inscription is almost illegible but clearly takes up very little space, leaving no room for the hymn or Edward Grant. M.W. on the FS is fainter than the subsequent 3 sets of initials, but they all tally with the HS, and since there is only a 10-year gap between deaths from 1878 to 1889, the last 3 cannot have been cut over any E.G. on HS or FS. Also Hill lists only 4 Walkers in grave.

Millward p. 215, tomb 256: In affectionate remembrance / of / Mary Walker / who died March 13th 1878 aged 61 years / Sun of my soul thou Saviour dear / it is not night when thou be near / O may no earth born cloud arise / to hide thee from thy servant's eyes / When the soft dews of kindly sleep / My wearied eyelids gently close / Be my last thought now sweet to rest / For ever on my Saviour's Bre
 Also of / Edward Grant / son in law of the above / who fell asleep in Jesus May 10th 1873 / aged 29 years / FS M.W. 1878 / E.G. 1873

1.11.78: As in Millward from 'In..' to '61 years', then :-
 Also Sarah Jane Walker / 7 daughter in law of the above ... Mary Walker / who departed this life ... 1889 / aged ... years /
 Also of William Walker / the beloved husband of Mary Walker / who died May 27 1893 / aged 75 years / with Christ which is far better /
 Also of William Walker / the beloved husband of Sarah Jane Walker / who died June 23 1913 aged 64 years / At rest
