Mary Fritchard / of (28 Heath) Street Hampstead / who died April
(8th) 1875 / in the fartyneventh year of his age / (In the midst
of life we are in death)
2. Gap about equivalent in size to above inscription, stone blistered
but not yet crumbling
3. Also Alfred Edward / the youngest son of Jason Fritchard / and
nephew of the above Henry Fritchard / who died January 30th 1878 /
aged 5 years and 9 months / Deeply lamented by his parents and friends
(F3: T.V. 1875 / A.B.C. 1878)

aged 46 years /
Also of / Mary Ann Harley / wife of the above / who died November 17th
1851 / aged 23 years / Underneath are the everlasting arms
