

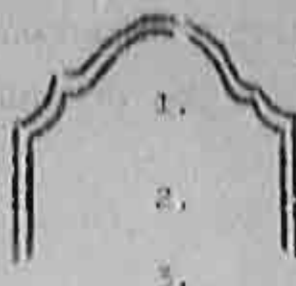

Mary Pritchard / of (28 Heath) Street Hampton / who died April
(8th) 1875 / in the fortyseventh year of his age / (In the midst
of life we are in death)
- Gap about equivalent in size to above inscription, stone blistered
but not yet crumbling
- Also Alfred Edward / the youngest son of James Pritchard / and
nephew of the above Henry Pritchard / who died January 30th 1878 /
aged 5 years and 2 months / Deeply lamented by his parents and friends
(PS: H.P. 1875 / A.R.P. 1878)

East side

In loving memory of / Henry Pritchard / who died April ... 1875 /
aged 46 years /
Also of / Mary Ann Marley / wife of the above / who died November 17th
1931 / aged 23 years / Underneath are the everlasting arms
