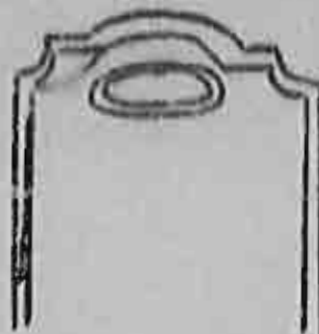

In Affectionate Remembrance of / William Slater / who died June 26th 1862 / aged 60 years / In the midst of life we are in death / also John Slater / son of the above / who died November 21st 1872 / aged 34 years / Rock of Ages cleft for me let me hide myself in thee / also Charlotte Slater / who died after long suffering / December 22nd 1886 aged 46 years / (.... 2 lines of Bible or hymn illegible)
