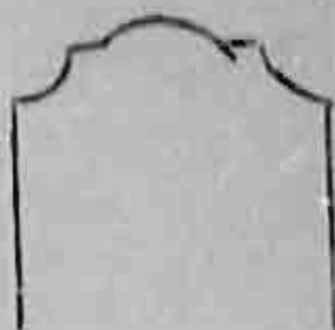

Inscription taken from Millward p. 145, t. 171

Sacred to the memory of / Mr. William Francis / who died  
 September 15th 1846 / aged 51 years /  
 Thus must thy flesh to silent dust descend  
 Thy mirth and worldly pleasures thus will end  
 Hear . now this preaching grave without delay  
 Believe repent and work while yet tis day  
 Make every day a critique on the past  
 And live each hour as if it were your last /

Also of Elizabeth Bird / sister in law of the above / who died  
 May 28th 1850 aged 73 years / also of Susannah Chattin /  
 sister of the above / who died July 26th 1861 aged 73 years /  
 also of Esther / relict of the above William Francis / and  
 sister of the above / Elizabeth Bird and Susannah Chattin /  
 who died August 10th 1868 / aged 73 years / a kind sister  
 and affectionate aunt
