

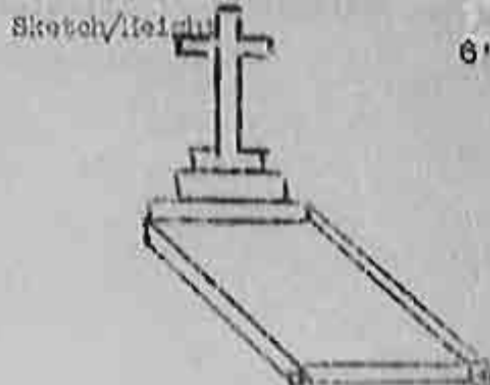

 who passed away 8th of March 1909 aged 77 / her children rise up and
 call her blessed her husband also / and he praiseth her / and of the
 above named Henry Clarke J.P. / who died on the 22nd July 1914
 aged 82 / 'Having served his generation he fell on sleep'
