

 who departed this life // on the 8th May 1822 // Aged 31 years//  
 This stone is placed as a mark of // respect by his brother  
 officers //

Also of Lieu. Charles Bull // of the said Regiment // who  
 departed this life // on the 1st April 1826 // in the 23rd  
 year of his age //

Also of Nicholas Bull // (Father of the above) Capt. & Adjutant //  
 in the same above named regiment // Who departed this life on //  
 the 16th April 1835 // Aged 63//
