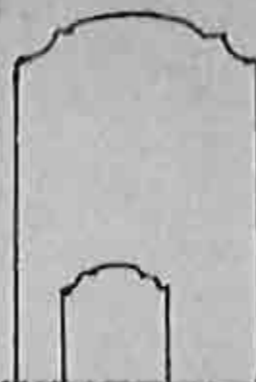

To the memory of // Mrs. Ann Glaisher // who departed
this life // the 26 May 1822 // in the 52nd year of
her age.

Forwell vain world I've had enough of thee // and
careless ever what thou sayst of me // Thy smiles
I court not nor thy frowns I fear // Blessed be the
Lord my head lies ----- here // The faults you've
seen in me take care to shun // And look at home there's
something to be done.

A.G. 1822. (on footstone)

NOTES: Since the head and footstones have nothing legible
left on them, I have deduced the 'inhabitant' of this
grave from the sequence of numbers in Millward, which
fits in with others on either side.
The dash in the inscription is also in Millward.
