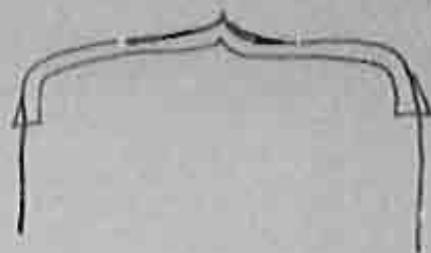

Carved round the top of the slab: The Memory of the Just is Blessed

Sacred to the memory of // Dorothy Chick // for fifty years the
Faithful // and attached servant of // Basil George & Mary
Woodd (sic) // of Hillfield in this Parish // She died 1st
Dec. 1857 // Aged 69 years.

Also of // Charles Chick // Husband of the above // Died
Feb. 10th 1837 // Aged 33 years.

NOTE: Charles seems to have been
16 years younger than Dorothy.
