On the cross shaft going downwards: In // loving memory // of // Thomas Sansome Preston // who entered into rest // March 3rd 1903, aged 66// and of Alice Rose, his beloved wife // who died February 6th 1925, aged 79//

On kerb at foot: "So he giveth his beloved sleep".

Left hand kerb: Helen Marion Preston daughter who died // April 7th. 1947 Aged 76.

Right hand kerb Margaret Rose Preston died January 31st // 1949, Aged 76.

Steps of cross, R.H. side In loving // and radiant // memory // of // Janie Maureen // Beloved eldest daughter of // Arthur Sansome and Mary Preston // (of Alexandria, Egypt) // who died January 24, 1923 // aged 18. "In the glad morning of my day // Lord of my life I come"//

Steps of cross L.H. side (top to bottom) Also of // Edith Alice Preston // Eldest daughter // who died at Oxford // September 10. 1920 aged 51 // "Requiescat in Pace".
