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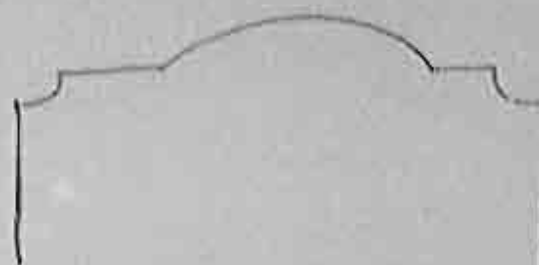

Jonathan Ware / father of the above children /
died 9 Decr 1834 aged 52 years /
Richard Ware / son of the above / died 28th Oct 1842 aged 28 years /
Mary Ware / wife of the above / died 10 Decr 1850 aged 66 years /
Sarah Bradshaw / daughter of the above /
died 15th May 1858 aged 30 (?) years
