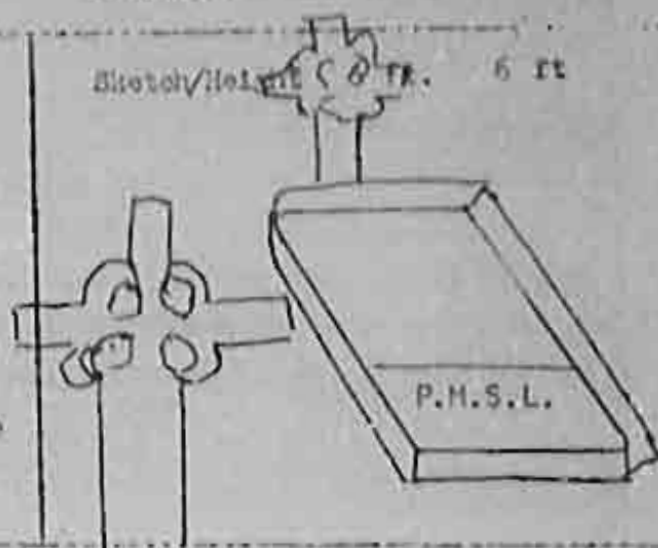

Cross: East: Beloved // Sydney Bridgman Gray //  
 died 6 May 1899 // aged 80.

Cross: West: Joseph Gray // born Feb. 9 1833 //  
 died April 26 1906.

Cross: South: Elizabeth Margaret // widow of // Joseph Gray //  
 died 27th Nov. 1925 // aged 87.

Cross: North: Ethel Maud Adney // nee Gray // died 16 July  
 1951 // aged 81 (Ashes)

Kerb: South: Fred. A. Adney // beloved husband of Ethel  
 Adney nee Gray // passed on May 12, 1935 aged 70. (Ashes)

Kerb: North: Also of Lily Margaret Gray died April 27 1953  
 aged 85. (Ashes)

Plaque Peter M.S. Latham // B. 1894, D. 1970 (Ashes).  
 And his wife // Angela // B 1894 D 1980

NOTE On the June 3<sup>(1976)</sup> (1976) the grave was completely covered with  
 lavender bushes and buzzing bees! The plaque to Peter  
 Latham was consequently not visible. On a 2nd visit in  
 January 1977 the lavender bushes had been chopped down.
