Eickhoff was a butcher in Flack Walk (not found in directaries) who changed his (German) name to Alexander in World War I to avoid trouble.

"My father was buried under his post-war name of Alexander (his second Christian name). Buried here also is his first son, Frederick William Eickhoff, who died 8th December 1925 aged 4 years, 5 months".
