

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS)

Millward pp. 133/4/5, No. 156

Sacred to the Memory of // Mrs. Elizabeth Forrester // of this Parish // who died June 29th 1821 // in the 83rd year of her age.

Also of Mr. Henry White Harding // who departed this life Mar. 6th 1835 // Aged 60 years // many years a respected inhabitant of this Parish // deeply (7 regretted) by his afflicted widow.

Friend is the question in thy heart engraved  
What shall I do to be for ever saved  
Believe in Jesus is the sole reply  
Believe in him & thou shall never die  
His precious blood gives pardon life & peace  
Freedom from guilt & joys that never cease.

Also Mrs. Mary Ann Harding // wife of the above // who died Dec. 3rd 1853 aged 74 years. // Far from a world of grief & sin // with God eternally shut in.
