INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS)

Millward No. 318, pp. 276/7, reads:

Sacred to the memory of / Eleanor / eldest daughter of William and Catherine Batchelour / of this Parish / who died Oct 11th 1824 / in the 12th year of her age / sleep on sweet girl await the Almighty's will / Then rise in Christ and be an angel still. /

Also of Catherine / mother of the above / who died Sept 29th 1860 / Aged 70 years / And now from worldly care set free / She's gone her Saviour's face to see. /

Also of the above named / William Batchelour / who died Jan 31st 1870 / Aged 81 years

Also of William Batchelour / son of the above / who died Feb 25th 1872 / Aged 48 years / I shall go to him but he shall not return to me /.

Existing stone, W. face, reads:

Sacred to the Memory / of / Eleanor, / eldest daughter of / William & Catherine Batchelour, / of this parish; / died 11th Oct 1824 / in her 12th year / also Catherine, / mother of the above, / died 29th Sept 1860 / aged 70 years / also ... an, / husband ... above / died 31 1870 / agedrs / also William Batchelour / son / died ... Feb 1872 / aged .. years / also / Rachael Susanna Batchelour / wife of the above, / died 15th Feb. 1914, / aged 88 years /.
