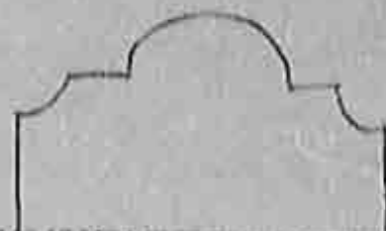

 at Kroonstad, South Africa / on Aug 15th 1957 / and his wife / Ann / who  
 died August 8th 1967 / Rest in Peace /
