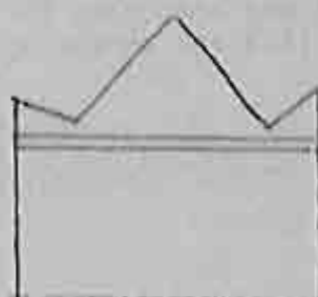

Magistrate / Born 1813 / Died at Penang August 9th 1865 /

Also / Elizabeth Earl / of Wildwood Hampstead / who died March 15th 1874 /
 aged 95 years
