 Kenneth Ross Mackenzie / Major 2nd. Batt. Seaforth Highlanders / Elder son of the above, aged 44 years / "missing" at Magersfontein, 11th Dec. 1899.

Inscription N. face:

Jessie / Harriet Isabel / Mackenzie / eldest daughter of / C.D. and J. Mackenzie died 6th December 1927 aged 71 / "Blessed are the pure in heart"

Inscription S. face:

Helen Harriet / Mackenzie / Commandant // 210 London / Younger daughter of / Charles Douglas Mackenzie / born 3rd Jan. 1872 / died 12th Nov. 1921, aged 49 /
