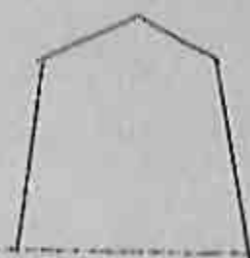

Beneath this stone are / deposited the remains of Harriet Hillyard / Cazenove / who was the sole surviving / daughter of James Gibson / of Epsom in the County of / Surrey Esquire / and wife of John Cazenove / formerly of this parish / obit 15th Decr. 1834 Aetat 39 / She was the mother of six / children of whom the eldest died / at the age of 8 years & was interred / at Boughton, the youngest but one / in its infancy & lies buried here /

Also of Louisa Harriet / who died on the 9th May 1835 / aged 16 years / and of James Robert / who died on the 17th of the same month / & year aged 20 months two / of the aforesaid surviving children /
