

Local history references: Deeds, 18 and 135; Title Map, occupier, 1841.

1820 Benjamin Cole bought a copyhold estate at West End, a messuage near the church, from Thomas Wilson.

1889, Barnes, talking about "Cole's Pond": "it was so named from a gentleman who occupied the large house near, and whose garden extended to the edge of the pond and was only separated therefrom by a high fence. The pond was chiefly used for watering horses, and also the roads, and when it was filled in it was enclosed and forms part of the garden belonging to the house referred to."
