MILLARD p. 1071, Lamb 210

South side: Here resteth/George Mounsey GRAY / who departed this life 10th January 1881 / aged 85 years /

Here resteth / Frances / wife of George Mounsey GRAY / who departed this life 20th March 1880 / aged 33 years /

North side: Also of / George Ridley / son of G.R. and F. GRAY / who departed this life / 20th February 1876 / aged 26 years /

\* According to the Millard sequence, this grave should be in the Old Churchyard, Plot 3H; but it is missing from there, as it must have been moved. (G.F. BERRY, moved also from 3H to G 100, Millard No. 703.)

It presumably replaces a previous stone on this spot, recorded thus in Millard 391, but now missing:

Sacred / to the memory of / Fanny the dear wife of / George Mounsey GRAY / of Upper Bedford Place / Strand Square / Esqr. / whose constant rest here expecting the sweet advent / of her Saviour / when he shall come to be glorified in his saints and to be admired in all them that believe / she died on the 20th March 1880 aged 33 /

Also of George Ridley GRAY / only son of the above who died on the 20th Feb / 1876 aged 26
