Also of Harriet GRIFFITH / wife of Edward GRIFFITH Esq / who departed this life / the 20th January 1855 /

Also Edward GRIFFITH Esq. E.B.S. / c. 32 Pitney Square London / for many years one of the Masters of H.M. Court of Common Pleas / at Westminster / who died Jan'y 8th 1858 aged 68 years /

Also Elizabeth Beatrice / daughter of the Rev<sup>d</sup> E.G. GRIFFITH M.A. / Rector of Winterbourne Cherborough Wilts / who died July 22nd 1864 aged 10 months /

Also Caroline Mary / youngest daughter of the above / Edward GRIFFITH Esq. and Harriet his wife / who died Sept 14th 1864 aged 4 1/2 years /

Also Harriet Emma / only surviving daughter of the same / who died August 14th 1869 / aged 52 years /
