And Samuel / who died in his infancy /

Also Henry John / son of Henry and Mary BALLS / who died 1st Oct 1865 / aged 29 years / His end was peace

Also of Alby the beloved wife of / William GARNIER / and late wife of H.J. BALLS / who departed this life 17th Oct 1871 / aged 44 years /

Also of Henry BALLS / father of the above / who departed this life 25 June 1879 / aged 74 years / Inseparable and unparted not by death for 14 yrs 1858-1872 1869-1879 (No footstone found 1984)

West face: In / loving memory of / Lydia Elizabeth / wife of Henry BALLS / who died 12th December 1909 / aged 98 years / Peace perfect peace
