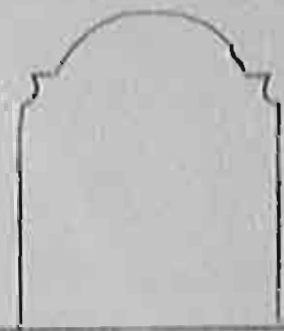

 Who died May 24th 1842, aged 33 years/ also/ in memory of Henry,
 the infant son/ of the above/ Henry and Elizabeth Styche/ who died
 June 18th 1842 aged 7 weeks/also/ to the beloved/remains
 of the above/ Henry Styche,/ who departed this life in perfect
 peace/ Feb 23rd 1853, in his 45th year./ Also to the
 memory of Sarah Susannah Styche/ relict of the above/
 who departed this life May 4th 1866/ aged 68 years.
 In hope of a blessed resurrection.
