

Sacred/ to the memory of/ Elizabeth/ wife of Henry Styche/  
 (of St. Lukes, Old Street)/ son of Joseph and Ruth Styche.  
 Who died May 24th 1842, aged 33 years/ also/ in memory of Henry,  
 the infant son/ of the above/ Henry and Elizabeth Styche/ who died  
 June 18th 1842 aged 7 weeks/ also/ to the beloved/ remains  
 of the above/ Henry Styche,/ who departed this life in perfect  
 peace/ Feb 23rd 1853, in his 55th year./ Also to the  
 memory of Sarah Susannah Styche/ relict of the above/  
 who departed this life May 4th 1866/ aged 68 years.  
 In hope of a blessed resurrection.

East facing inscription:

Also of/ Mary Carr/ younger daughter of/ W.A. and H. Styche/  
 born Feb 16th 1839, died June 13th 1928/ also of/  
 Elizabeth Annie Styche/ younger daughter of/ Joseph  
 Henry and Charlotte Styche/ born 16th 1867 died  
 Oct 14th 1930.
