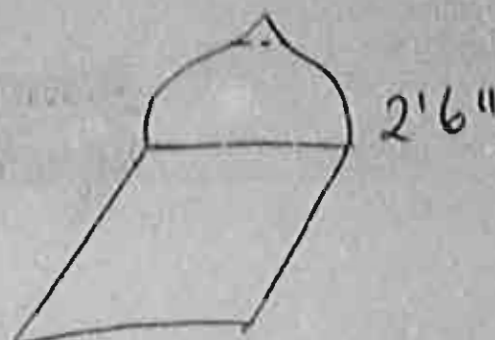

 who died September 9th 1876 aged 64 years /
