

INB, Dict. British Architects (Ware), Miss Dionys Moore:

Stone designed by his son-in-law, Leslie T. Moore.

Temple Lushington Moor - as articulated to George Gilbert Scott Junior
1875, and then became his assistant.

Later in partnership with his son-in-law, Leslie T. Moore (no blood relation).
Much church building and restoration, especially in Yorkshire.

Before 1892 lived 6 Downshire Hill

1892 - 1920 " 46 Well Walk

NB Architect, p. 1912, of Parish Church enlargement - Clergy and
open crypt cloister (i.e. south wing); and Lady Chapel extension 4'6"
westwards between altar and altar rail and inclusion of previous
clergy vestry.
