

Also their fourth son/Michael/An undergraduate who was drowned at Oxford/
while bathing/19th May 1921 and who lies a few yards from here aged 20.

Also their second son/John/Commander Royal Navy/who died at Port Gaverne,
Cornwall/17th September 1959 aged 65/Also their third son/Peter/Soldier MC
and Publisher/Born 25th February 1897/Died 5th April 1960/whose ashes lie
