

Arthur, a barrister, son of Rev. J. Llewelyn Davies (see K 1), married Sylvia, second daughter of George du Maurier (q.v. in I Bay), in 1892. Their five sons met J.M. Barrie in 1897 and inspired his Peter Pan (1903). When their parents died tragically young, Barrie adopted them.

Their story has been written by Andrew Birkin and dramatised for TV as The Lost Boys.

Michael Llewelyn Davies has his own grave at J 11.
