

DAVIES John Llewelyn 1836 - 1916. Broad church theologian and author, supporter of higher education for women and of ~~Trade Unions~~ Hon. chaplain to the king, ~~Geographical~~ Mountaineer who made first ascent of Dwy and Tashhorn. Early member of Alpine Club. Married (1859) ~~Married~~ daughter of Sir Charles Crompton. She died 1895. He retired from vicarage in 1908 and spent last years of his life with his daughter in Hampstead.
