

Three James Smiths in Hampstead are mentioned in Pigot's Directory of Middlesex 1840 - a builder, a chemist, a corn dealer, - perhaps the most likely candidate - a builder.

James Smith, builder, is mentioned in deeds 52 - 3 in Hampstead Public Library dating from 1842-3. By 1874 he was dead/see Deed 84. Also appears in Tithe Map of Hampstead 1841.
