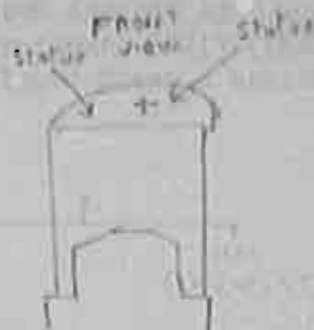

S Side: Father I will that they also whom thou hast given/me be with me where I am John XVII 24/In memory of Sarah Hannah/the beloved wife of Robt Prance Esq. of Frognal/In this Parish/who departed this life May 5th 1847 aged 45 years/Also of Mary Anna eldest daughter of the above/who departed this life May 9th 1847/aged 12 years

E. In memory of/John Howard France/third son of Robert France Esq/ of this Parish/who died March 6th 1837/aged 6 years/Suffer little children to come unto me and forbid/them not for such is the Kingdom of God Mark: 10. The family vault of Robert France Esq.

N. In memory of/Mary BrowningBooke / mother of Sarah Hannah, wife of Robert France, Esq/who died May 11th 1850 aged 79 years/Also of Jane France his sister/who died Dec 13 1863 aged 68 years/And also of Charles Harry/fourth son of the above Robert and Sarah Hannah France/who died at Frognal July 8th 1878 in his 46th year.

W. In memory of/Robert France Esq. JP/late of Frognal/who died July 15 1869/aged 70 years/Also of Reginald Heber France/of The Ferns Frognal Lane/second son of the above/who died July 20th 1912/aged 83 years/Also of/Edith France/of the Ferns, Frognal Lane/third daughter of the above/Robert France Esq. JP/who died Feby 16th 1920/aged 81 years
