- S Sacred to the memory of/Edward Carlile Esq/merchant of London/Born at Paisley in Scotland/Many years an inhabitant of this Parish/who died 16 August 1833 aged 67 years/Deeply lamented.
- E James Ewlyn Carlile Esq/only son of/Edward and Elizabeth Carlile/Born Oct 9 AD 1803/Died 1859 Aged 55 (?) years/A resident of Hampstead/for many years.
- N Sacred to the memory of/Elizabeth/relict of Edward Carlile Esq/who died 20th Jul 1838/aged 66 years.
