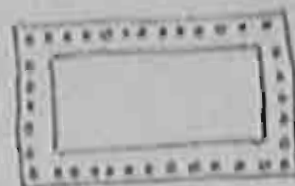

 Jan ? 1832 aged 2 years and 7 months/ Also the remains of William Brooks Esq/  
 father of the above/who died July 24 1866/in his 75th year/Also the remains  
 of/Margaret Jane Brooks/widow of the above William Brooks/who died December 22nd  
 1870/in her 73rd year/Louisa..... oaks/.....band..../who d..../aged.....years/  
 Also of/Adeline Brooks/ ..er of/William.....Brooks.....in her 6.....years  
 Rest in peace.
