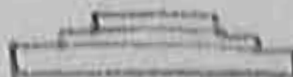

Present inscription: To the memory of/John Stayner Bosanquet/who died 17th April 1824/aged 21/Henry Ferdinand Bosanquet/who died 5th March 1829/aged 23/Charles Holford Bosanquet/who died 19th Decemb. 1834/They were the sons of Charles Bosanquet/of the First Hampstead Heath/who died 20th June 1850/aged 81/and Charlotte Anne his wife/daughter of Peter Holford/of Westonbirt Gloucestershire/who died 15th February 1830/aged 68/they are both buried at/Rook in Northumberland.

Inscription as in Millward: Top:

p. 22, no. 6

To the memory of/Charlotte Anne/daughter of Peter Holford Esq/of Weston Birt Gloucestershire/wife of/Charles Bosanquet Esq/of the First Hampstead in this parish/she died and is buried at Rook in Northumberland/on the 15th Feby 1839/ aged 68/ Charles Bosanquet Esquire/of the First Hampstead/in this parish Died (and was buried) at Rook/in the County of Northumberland on the 20th June 1850/aged 81.

E Side John Stayner/Fourth son of Chas Bosanquet Esq/died 17th Apr 1824/in the 22nd year of his age

S Side Charles Holford Bosanquet/of Lincoln's Inn Barrister at law/Died 19th Dec 1831/In the 37th year of his age

W Side Henry Frederick/Bosanquet/Died 5th March 1829/aged 23
