Sacred to the memory of Mary McMillan/wife of Buchanan McMillan of Bow Street Covent Garden, London/who departed this life on the 8th September 1815/in the 68th year of her age/She was an affectionate wife/a friend to the friendless/Benevolent without ostentation/Truly hospitable/And blessed with a warmth of heart/That endeared her to those who best knew her/...
Buchanan McMillan/died on 6th September 1832/at Belladium House Invernesshire/aged 76.

E. Side. Mem. Sac/In this vault are deposited/the mortal remains of/Mary/the beloved wife of Mr Harrison Blagdon/and daughter of Buchanan McMillan/who departed this life on 26 June 1826/In 45th year of her age/She was a dutifull daughter/an exemplary faithful wife /

W. Side. Edward Harrison Blagdon died Nov 1 1862 aged 81 years.
