This Arthur Watts was a cartoonist with Punch from 1911 and
illustrated Both Sides of the Microphone for Radio Times from 1928.

The attic of 1 Holly Place was his studio 1911-35.

He married Marjorie Dawson Scott, daughter of the founder of the
P.E.N. Club, as his second wife. He was killed in a civil air
crash, July 1935.
