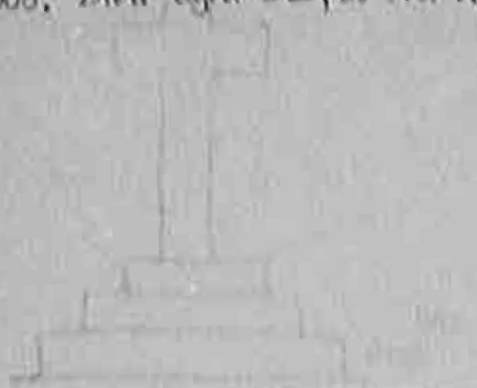


letter from daughter, Cicely Wells Thorpe, 17a Grediton Hill, SW6 URS, 8.7.1984

Thomas W-T studied brewing in Vienna after leaving Gundle. At the end of the 19 c. he joined Mann Grossman & Paulin in Whitechapel, whom he left as Chairman in 1918. Introduced many new technical changes in brewing methods and reforms in affairs of the work force. Founder member of the Van Horne Parade in Regents Park. Lived 52 Redington Road in a new house built on the Maryon Wilson estate in 1908. Died ^{here} aged 92, as did his widow.
