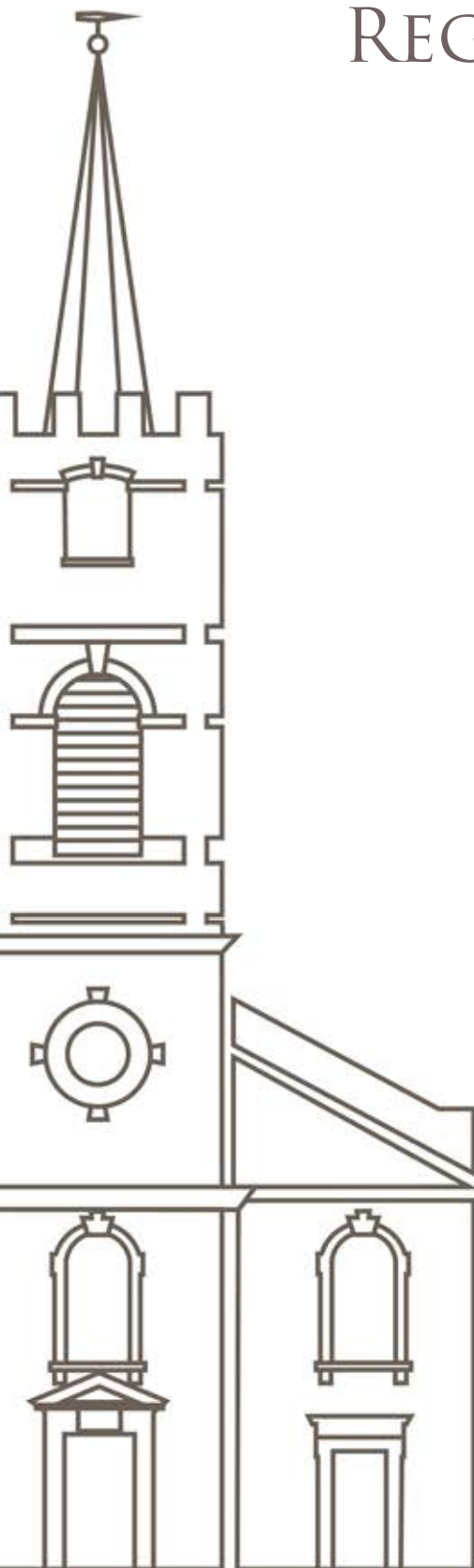


# THE PARISH CHURCH OF ST JOHN-AT-HAMPSTEAD
