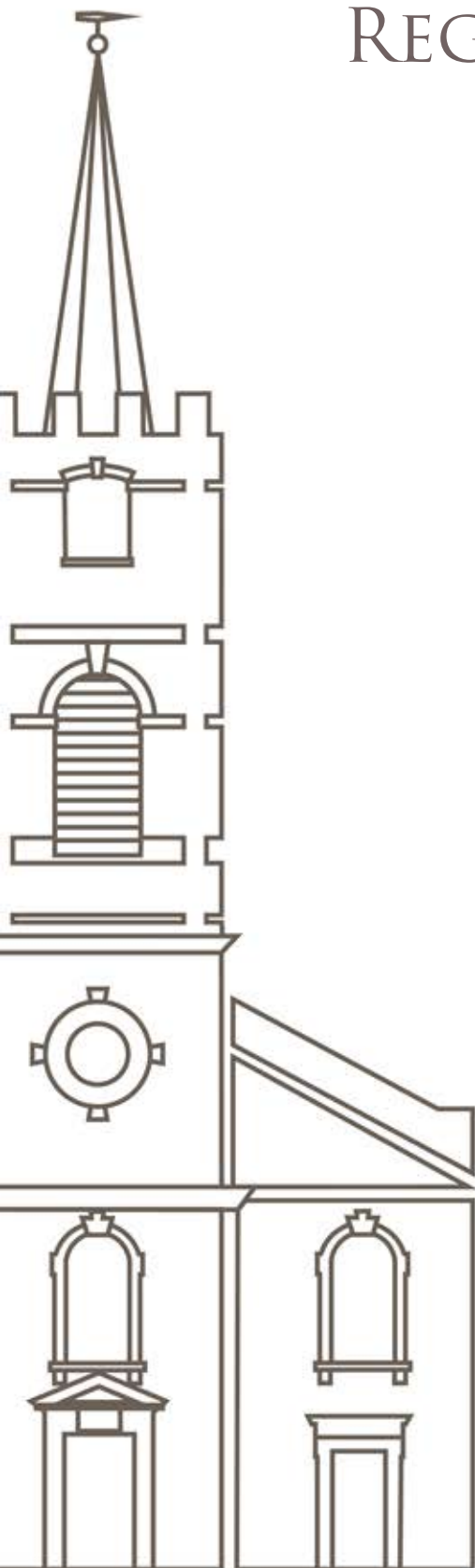
The original material is in the London Metropolitan Archives which is administered by the The City of London Corporation.
