Ann Askew / who departed this life on the 3rd of June 1814 aged 77 years /

Anthony Minacre Askew / who departed this life on the 12th of June 1818 aged 59 years /

Richard Askew Esq<sup>re</sup> / late Major of the 27th Foot / who departed this life on the 21st of December 1828 aged 98 years /

Anthony Askew, <sup>1723</sup> MD, FRS / who exchanged this life for a better / the 28th day of February 1774 / in the 52nd year of his age /
