

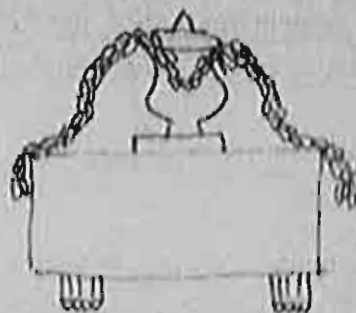

Sacred to the memory of / Anthony Askew MD, FRS / who departed this life on the 27th of February 1774 aged 52 years /

Mary Askew / who departed this life on the 9th of January 1786 aged 14 years /

Lucy Askew / who departed this life on the 4th of June 1797 aged 5 months /

Ann Askew / who departed this life on the 3rd of June 1814 aged 77 years /

Anthony Linacre Askew / who departed this life on the 12th of June 1818 aged 59 years /

Richard Askew Esq^r / late Major of the 27th Foot / who departed this life on the 21st of December 1828 aged 98 years /

Park p. 340

Anthony Askew, ^{MD, FRS} / who exchanged this life for a better / the 28th day of February 1774 / in the 52nd year of his age /

And also of Mary Askew / his younger daughter / who died the 9th day of January 1786 / in the 14th year of her age
