

DNB: Classical scholar, physician to St Bartholomew's and Christ's Hospitals.
Left extensive library, which realised £4,000 at auction.

Park, p. 340: Married Elizabeth, daughter of Robert Holford
(Master in Chancery), who died 1711 and had a
monument in Hammersmith Chapel.

DNB says he married Elizabeth Holford and had 12 children by her.

Lysene says this was the only monument in the church (rebuilt 1747) at the
time of writing (1796). It was at the "west end, where the
communion table was". Does he mean "east end"?
