In memory of / George Henry Errington Esquire / formerly of Cotton Hall in the
 County of Stafford / and late of Colchester / who died on the 6th of March 1848, in
 the 66th year of his age / and is buried in a vault in the adjoining ground /
 He was the grandson of George Errington Esquire / who for some years in the
 middle of the last century / was a resident of this parish / and an active
 magistrate for the county / and great grandson of John Errington of York /
 of direct lineage from the ancient family of the Erringtons / of Errington in
 the county of Northumberland / who were seated there at the time of the conquest /
