

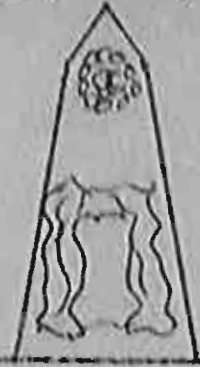

 Also of / Mrs Sarah Cartwright / who died April 12th 1828 / aged 85 years /
