Gift Aid is linked to basic tax rate, currently 20%, which allows charities to reclaim 25p for every £1 donated.

2. If you pay income tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.

3. Should two or more persons wish to make Gift Aid donations, a separate Gift Aid declaration form must be signed by each of them. **Two or more persons cannot be included on the same form.**
