

These are probably members of the KINDER and ENFIELD families who lived in the houses on Windmill Hill near Joanna Baillie and her sister. (Baines, pp. 543/4.)

Henry Enfield supported the Provident Dispensary (New End) and left his name on his house. He is shown as Henry Enfield Esq (not Dr.) in the 1854 Directory.

Henry Sharpe of Admiral's House married an Eliza Kinder in 1834 (see Sharpe's grave XB 136) (Caen History Review 2, p. 2)
