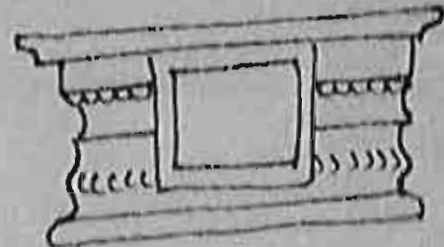

 Turner / peccator / Also the body of / Mrs Elizabeth Turner / his widow who
 departed this life / 4th June 1772 aged 59 years / Also the body of Nathaniel Turner
 Esq. / of Stoke Hall Suffolk / eldest son of John Turner / who departed this life
 the 15th of / June 1791 aged 53 years / Also the body of Mrs Elinor Turner / wife
 of Mr John Turner of Putney / (and only daughter of the late / Mr Maurice Griffith)
 / who died 13th December 1800 / aged 58 years.
