

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward p. 858, tomb 370

North Side: This tomb is erected by/Mrs Marianne MATHIAS granddaughter of / William & Ann POPPLER whose names are on the other side /

Here likewise are deposited the remains of / her dear husband Vincent MATHIAS Esq / to whose most valuable memory she also consecrates this tomb / as a perpetual monument of her love esteem & Veneration for a most affectionate husband and a most virtuous man / He departed this life 14 June 1782 aged 66 years /

Here also are deposited the remains of / Mrs Marianne MATHIAS widow of Vincent MATHIAS Esq a lady whose understanding knowledge talents piety benevolence & every active / & exemplary Christian virtue made her the object of love & esteem throughout her / whole life and of the deepest & most unfeigned regret sorrow & reverential / regard to her friends and family at her departure / She was born September the 8th 1724 and died on the 8th of January 1799 /
